Dear Past, Present, or Potential Mokelumne River Water User:

The North San Joaquin Water Conservation District invites you to an informational workshop on the District's new Tracy Lake Recharge Project. The project will involve a new diversion facility downstream of Lodi Lake that will divert Mokelumne River water into Tracy Lake for groundwater recharge purposes; and to provide irrigation water to nearby vineyards. The project is being funded with a federal grant, and assessments on the lands that will receive the irrigation water.

The District would like to hear from Lower Mokelumne River water users regarding any concerns about the proposed project so that those concerns may be addressed as the project moves forward. This meeting is open to the public.
